Here is a list of the minimum “must have uniform”

This is what we will be in most of the time when in and around camp and that is why it is under minimum requirements.

We should all look the same according to this minimum standard.

This will be known as our field or combat dress.

SADF issue Brown Combat boots (Army), or black combat boots (Navy and SAAF)



Webbing (green canvas)

This is the easiest and cheapest to find hence we will not be using the Pat 83 nylon webbing.

Here is a list of dress uniform (nice to have)

“Not essential but we will dress in this style of uniform for formal matters including:

- When on bivouac and ‘stepping out’ as a group.
 - Normally on Saturday / Sunday Events
 - Flag parade
 - Formal group photo.

The unit/regiment/ARMY/SAAF/NAVY/SAMS is your choice but please stick to the unit/regiment/ARMY/SAAF/NAVY/SAMS items of the uniform you choose.

Note: Your choice must be ratified by the Group Committee.
